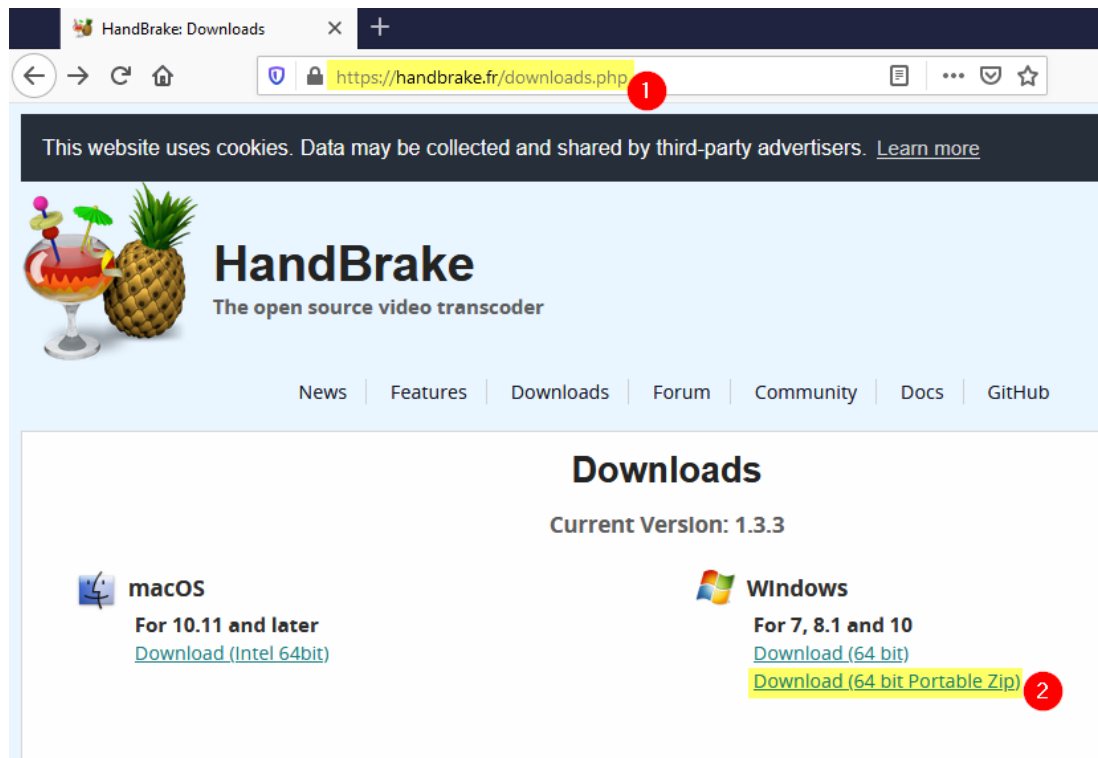


Installing HandBrake on Windows 10

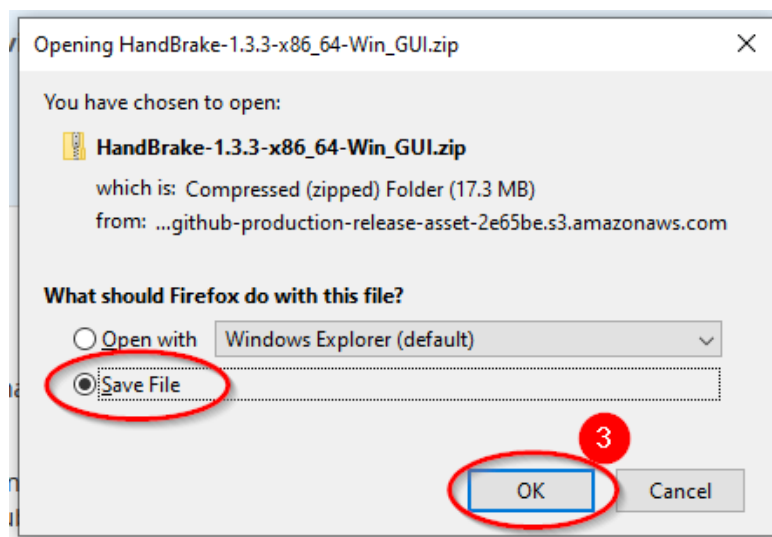

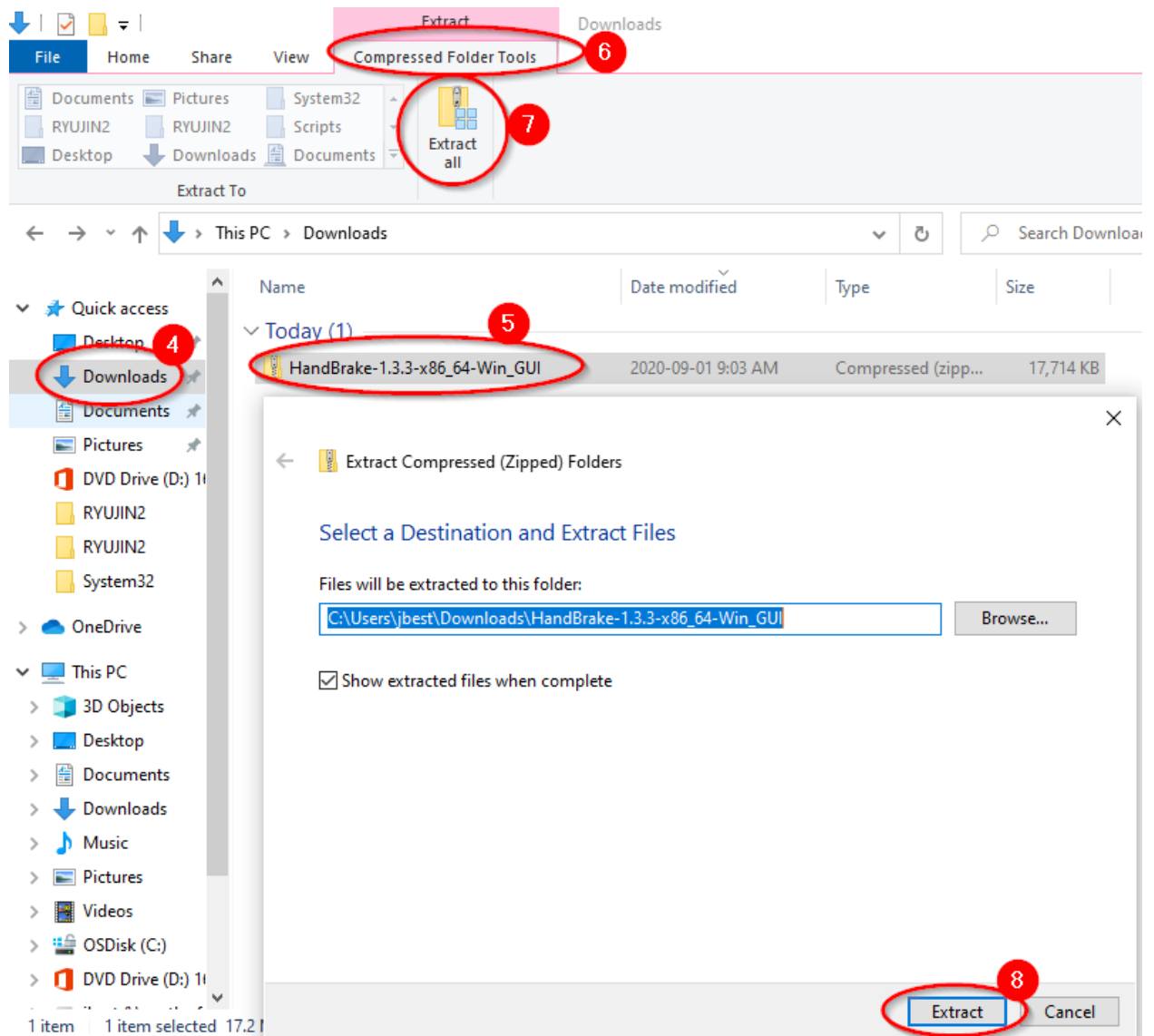
1. Open the [HandBrake download site](https://handbrake.fr/downloads.php) in your browser
2. Click **Download (64 bit Portable Zip)**



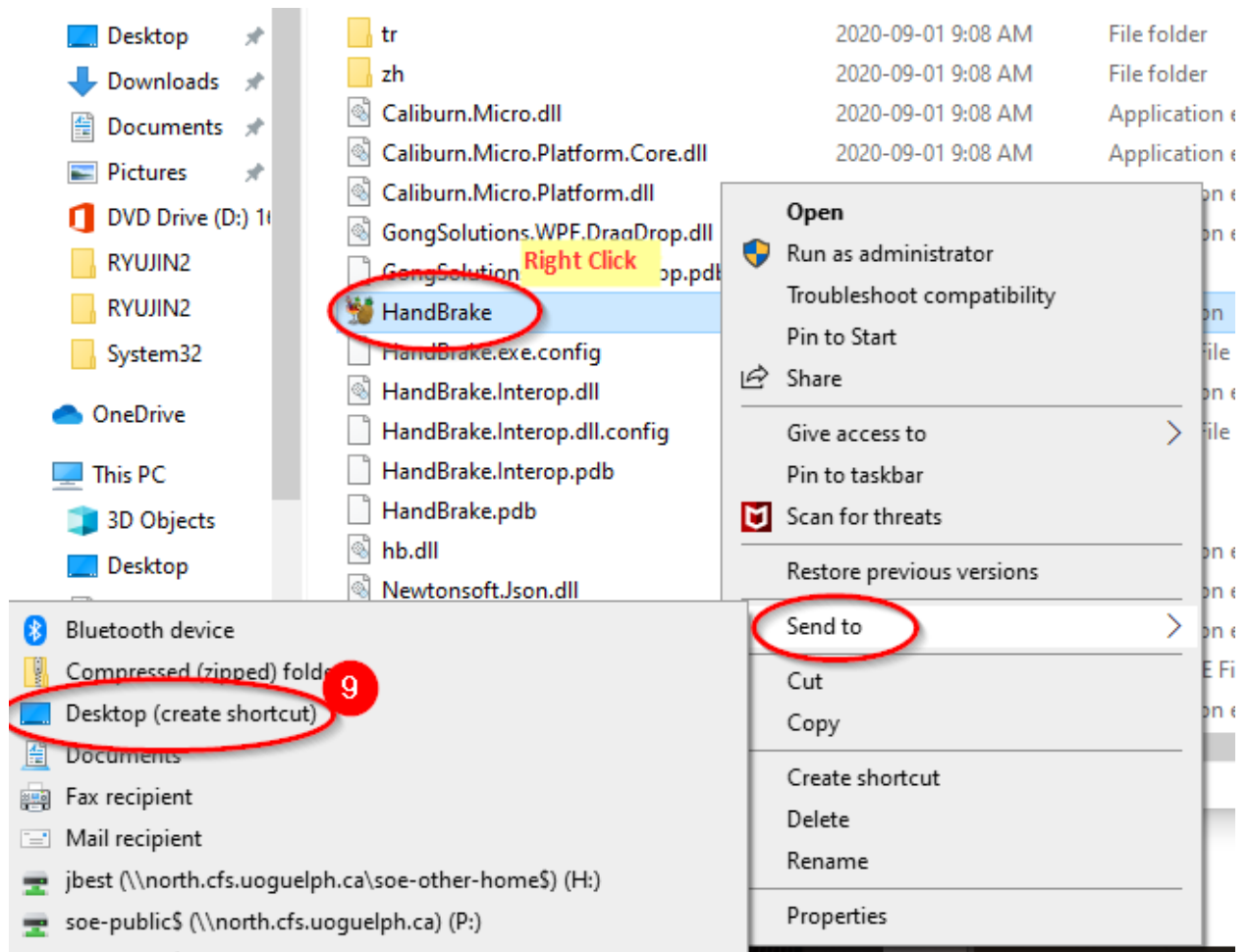
3. If prompted, select **Save File** and click OK



4. Open Windows Explorer (press **Windows** + E) and then open **Downloads** from the left side
5. Click on the zip file you just downloaded
6. In the ribbon menu along the top of the window, click **Compressed Folder Tools**
7. Click **Extract all**
8. In the dialog, confirm the folder is correct and click **Extract**



9. Once the extraction is complete, it will open the destination folder. **Right-click** on the **HandBrake** item and select **Send to** → **Desktop (create shortcut)**



Compressing a Video using HandBrake

10. Launch **HandBrake** from the shortcut on your desktop you created:





11. In the Source Selection window, click **File – Open a single video file**

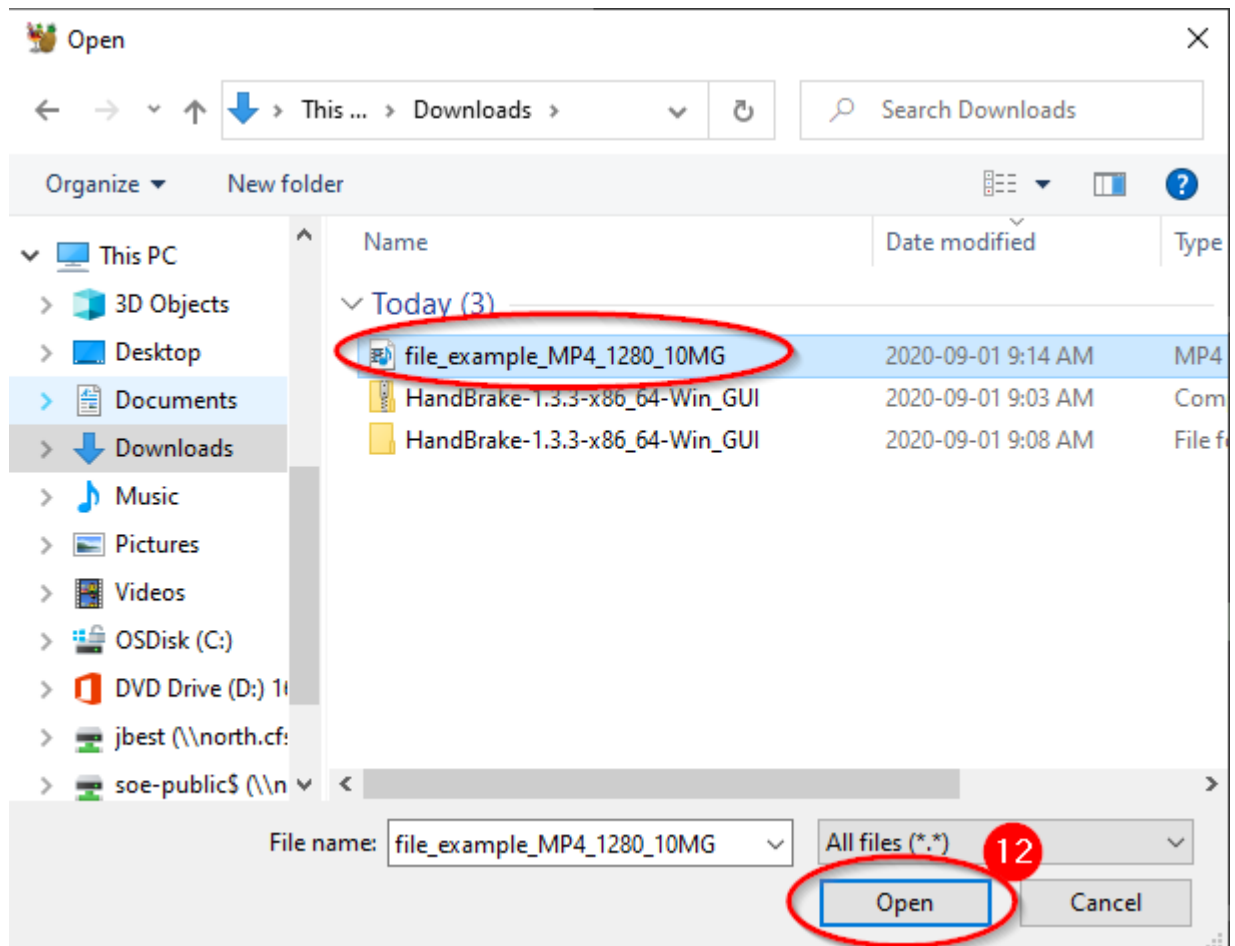

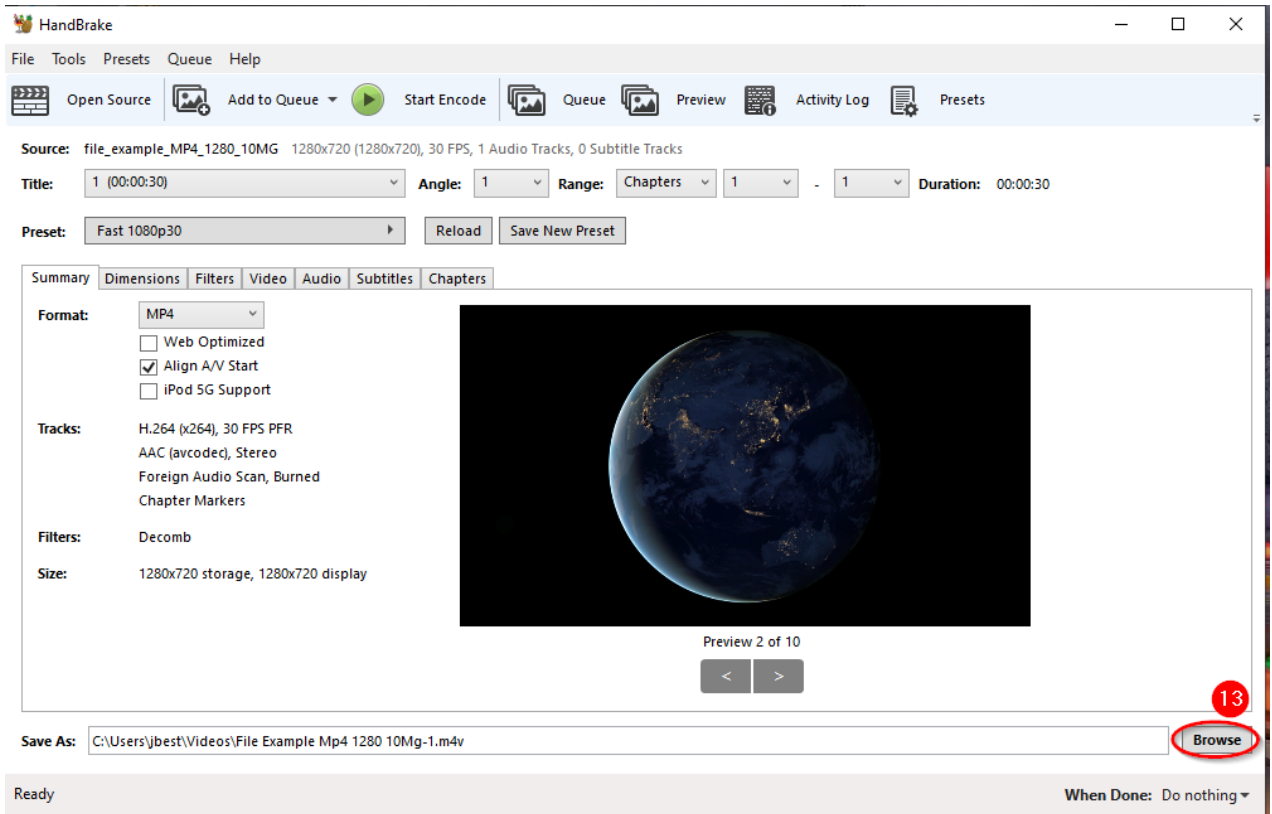

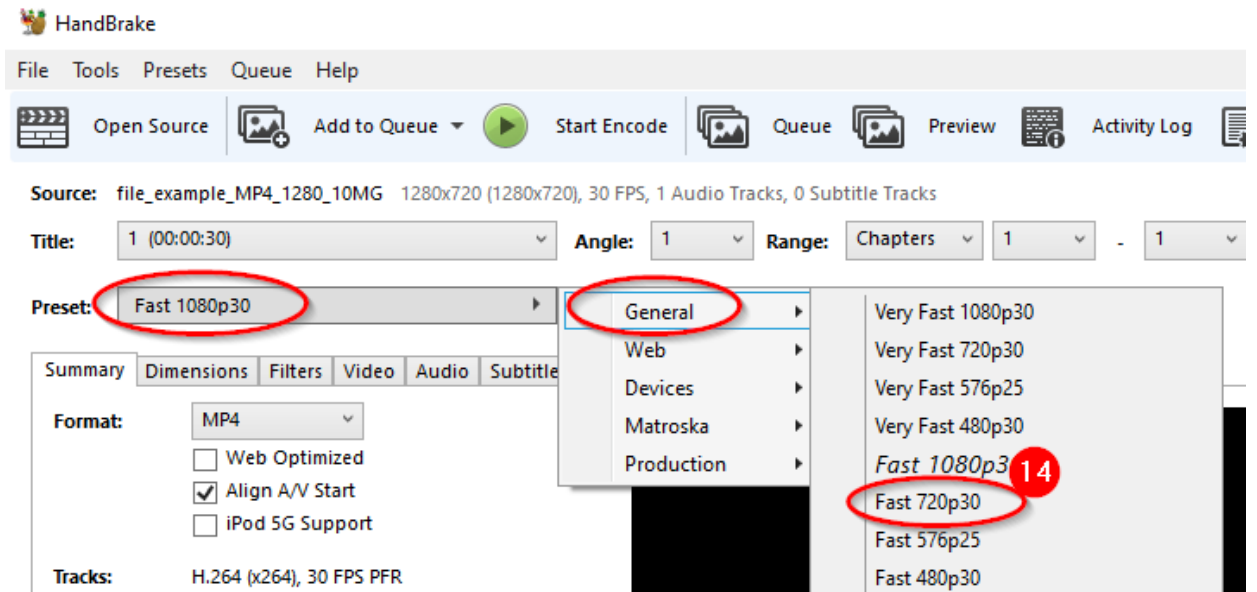
12. Browse to the video you'd like to compress, select it, and click **Open**



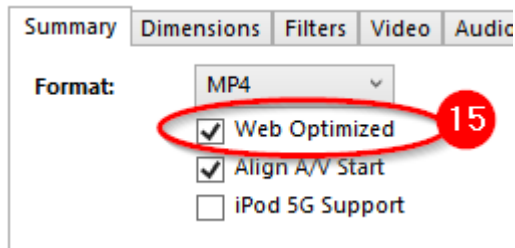
13. Click **Browse** and select where you'd like to save the compressed video



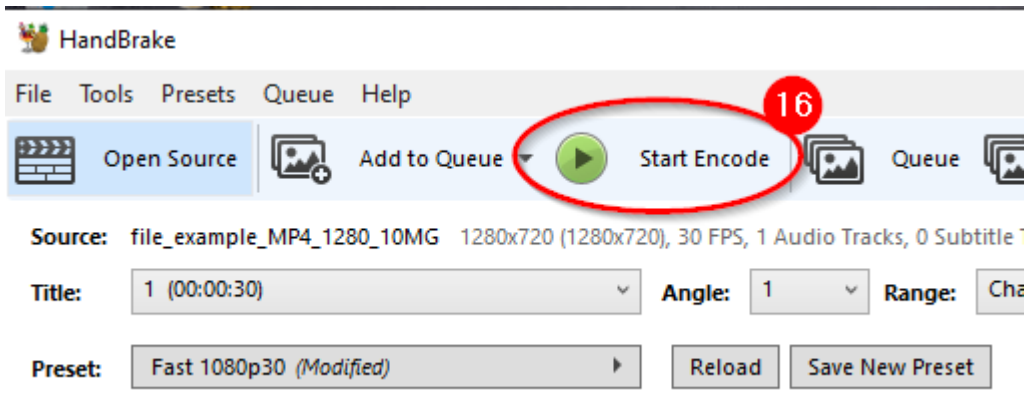
14. Next to **Preset**, select General → **Fast 720p30**



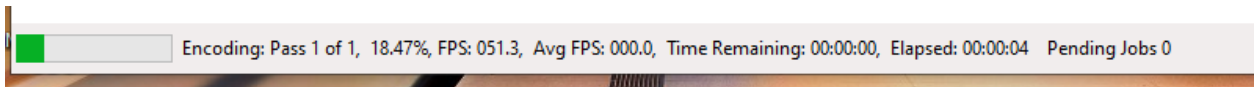
15. Under **Format** check the box for **Web Optimized**



16. Click **Start Encode** in the top toolbar



17. You can see the time remaining in the status bar along the bottom:



18. Once completed, you should find your compress video in the location you specified earlier
